Judges will evaluate the nomination utilizing the following criteria. A nominee does not need to have initiatives for all the criteria:

- 1. Significant advancement to reduce overall fleet carbon emissions and other environmental impacts:
 - a. Alternate vehicular fuels, vehicles or infrastructure,
 - b. Electric or hybrid-electric vehicles or charging infrastructure,
 - c. Reducing vehicle miles traveled and idling.
 - d. Increasing fleet fuel efficiency,
 - e. Right-sizing fleets and vehicles to missions,
 - f. Operational environmental management practices and procedures (e.g. recycling used oil and use of recycled oil in vehicles, use of environmentally friendly fluids and chemicals, waste recycling, controlling spills and runoff impacts, etc.)
- 2. Unique, innovative, or creative approaches to deploy the strategies listed above.
- 3. Established and achieved specific, measurable results.
- 4. The advancement of EPACT and US DOE or other state/local jurisdictional goals for improving air quality, environmental impacts, and reducing dependence on foreign oil.
